### SERIOUS REMINDERS: BURNING and FERTILIZER

• As you begin spring work on your yard **please** remember that Douglas County Ordinance restricts burning within 100 feet of the lake shore or any drainage area. Burning closer than 100 feet requires the use of a fire ring. Ashes are very high in phosphorus content and a major contributor to algae and weed growth.
