As a Good Neighbor please consider...

Parking: Vehicle parking should be on driveways and designated parking areas. Trailers may be parked in designated grass areas set back from neighbors. Refrain from parking on streets and never block neighboring driveways.

Occupancy: The number of overnight guests and visitors to rental properties is limited by County Ordinance. This property is licensed for ____ overnight guests and ____ persons on the property.

Garbage: Please keep the property and lakeshore free of trash. Refuse should be stored in the containers provided and kept out of sight. Douglas County encourages recycling so please do your part.


Please keep in mind...

Be aware...

Some lakes in Douglas County contain aquatic invasive species (AIS) and/or have restricted areas for boating. Please help to keep AIS from spreading by cleaning, draining, and drying all boats and equipment, and disposing of bait and attached weeds. 
